

Senior Application Timeline Fall 2014

August 2014

- Register for any remaining ACT or SAT.
- Meet with your College Counselor to finalize list of schools.
- Create an account with the Common Application at www.commonapp.org
- Identify at least two teachers you would like to ask to write letters of recommendation on your behalf. Fill out a Recommendation Request through Naviance. Students should give sufficient notice to teachers.

September 2014

- Barrett, The Honors College at ASU application opens online.
- September 12—Registration deadline for the October 11 SAT.
- September 12—Registration deadline for October 11 SAT Subject Tests (check with the university to see if it's required). Test dates vary by subject. Students can register for up to three Subject Tests on a single test date.
- August 8—Registration deadline for the September 13 ACT.
- Military Academy Applications should be completed this month.
- Meet with college representatives when they visit your school
- Ask teachers for letters of recommendation. Be sure to give teachers sufficient notice. Apply to ASU, NAU, and U of A to meet scholarship and housing deadlines.
- **September 27**—College Symposium and Essay Writing Workshop at Scottsdale Prep.

October 2014

- October 9—Registration deadline for the November 8 SAT.
- October 9—Registration deadline for November 8 SAT Subject Tests.
- Continue to meet with college representatives.
- Schedule college admissions interviews with universities.
- Submit CSS Profile, if necessary, for financial aid if applying early.
- Revise your college essay/personal statement. Have your counselor edit it!
- Students applying to an Early Action or Early Decision should complete their applications by the November 1 deadline (varies with some schools.)

November 2014

- November 1/November 15--deadline for most Early Action/Early Decision applications.
- November 15—priority deadline for Barrett, The Honors College at ASU.
- Students should strive to complete remaining college applications before Thanksgiving.
