Testing Update

The State of Arizona updated their menu of assessments and removed the SAT from their menu of options. Due to that change we will now offer the following:

PSAT, National Merit Qualifying Exam (10th and 11th) – October **Aspire** (9th grade) – Spring 2022 **Pre-ACT** (10th grade) – Spring 2022 **ACT** (11th grade) – March 2022

In addition to these changes, the new state exam for 7th and 8th graders is the Arizona Academic Standard's Assessment (AASA). AzSCI will still be administered to 9th and 11th graders.
