





It would take many pages to detail all that we discussed, but here are a few highlights:

Gladiator Teams

Gladiator Teams are a long tradition at North Phoenix Prep. Each team is named after a type of historical Roman gladiator. In the spring, we select a group of twenty 9th and 10th grade students (Lanistae) who will lead the teams for the year, and in the 1st quarter we place new middle school students onto teams. We plan activities to take place with teams every other Friday, as well as two big field day events, one in October and one in May. Teams compete in events to earn tickets, and they can also earn tickets for getting caught doing virtuous actions at school, such as helping another student, keeping our school clean, or study events held in class! We keep tally of the tickets each week and post the standings in the hallway. We use these earnings to determine the winners each semester and treat the winning teams to prizes at the end of the semester.

This past Thursday, our Gladiator Team leaders held the 10th annual Team Draft to choose students for teams! In almost all cases we were able to assign each student to one of their top three team choices.

On Friday, 9/24, we will announce the team assignments and have our first Familia Friday! Middle School students will eat lunch in their team room with their Editors (teacher leaders) and Lanistae (student leaders), who will have an activity for them to get to know each other and start making connections on their team.

Since students are on the same team for all of middle school, they may use these shirts that whole time.
