## **Dress Code**

At Great Hearts schools, the student uniform is an essential part of who we are and what we do. The uniform serves to unify our students as one community of learners, irrespective of our diverse backgrounds. The uniform also signifies to the larger community our common purpose and identity as schools in pursuit of the true, the good, and the beautiful. Finally, the uniform frees our students to pursue their intellectual and moral development as individuals, without the distractions of fad and fashion. True individuality is formed in the heart and mind, not in appearances.

As we begin Semester 2, the dress code needs to be revisited and subsequently enforced. Please review the uniform policy with your scholars: **NPX Dress Code**.

## Key Areas of Focus

**Belts:** A solid-colored black or dark brown belt must be worn with the dress pants or shorts. Dress belts with a simple clasp or open buckle designs are acceptable.

**Outerwear:** Sweaters and sweatshirts may be worn for warmth before and after school but must be stored in lockers and remain in during school hours. NPX uniform sweaters may be worn throughout the school day. This includes NPX sweatshirts, blazers, and Letterman jackets. \*\*Personalized items may only be worn by the owner.

**Jewelry:** Girls have the option of wearing one pair of matching earrings (no other body piercings are permitted), one watch, one finger ring, and one necklace...Girls may wear one tasteful, non-distracting bracelet. Boys are permitted to wear one watch, one finger ring, and one necklace. All jewelry must be tasteful and worn in a non-distracting manner; gaudy costume or novelty jewelry is not uniform attire.

**Earrings:** Earrings must be worn on the ear lobe and cannot hang more than one-half inch below the ear lobe.

**Necklaces:** Only fine-gauged, 16 to 20 inch, silver or gold chain necklaces are permitted. Necklace pendants, if worn, must be less than an inch in length, width, or diameter.

Reminder: Backpacks, tote bags, and lunch containers must be kept in the lockers.

# **Cell Phone Usage**

Upon entry into the Academic Building, student cell phones are to be placed inside the student's backpack, which will remain inside their locker for the duration of the school day. Cell phones are not to be removed from backpacks until students have exited the Academic Building. No cell phone is to be used inside the school building or in the courtyard. Students observed with their phones on campus will be required to turn them in and may pick them from the Dean's office after school.

## **Self Defense Course**

Michael Kaneen and 9 Dragons Kung Fu is pleased to present a practical course in self-defense for North Phoenix Preparatory Academy female students, parents/guardians, and NPX Faculty (and their family members). This course focuses on the key aspects of self-defense for women, including knowledge, instinct, preparation, situational awareness, and specific techniques for repelling a physical attack.

The program will be conducted by a corps of certified instructors at the facilities of 5 Elements Kung Fu in three, two-hour classes. Sessions will be held on Saturday afternoons in January (the 29<sup>th</sup>) and February (the 5<sup>th</sup> and the 12<sup>th</sup>). There will be one make-up session in February (the 19<sup>th</sup>) for participants who have missed a class.

The program is open to all female Prep students (grades 7 to 12) as well as their parent(s)/guardian, and all teachers and staff of North Phoenix Prep. Registration is limited to 40 participants on a first-come, first-served basis. Payment is required in advance, and liability waivers must be completed for each participant prior to taking part in the lessons. Registration fees are not refundable.

# **Latin Bootcamp**

Salvēte, Familiae!

(Greetings, families!) This is Ms. Coffey, teacher of Latin and Greek. I want to let you know about an amazing opportunity for your Latin students. This semester, I am running Latin Boot Camp, and it's open to any NPX Latin student! I know that Latin is a challenging course, and can feel dismal and boring when students feel they have fallen behind. Latin Boot Camp targets key sets of noun and verb endings which every student must know, but which we do not necessarily review in the classroom each week. Boot Camp starts with a quick review in my classroom, after which we migrate outside (where the weather has been excellent) and march and chant the endings. At the end of the session, each student takes a rapid-fire verbal quiz to see if they have achieved short-term memorization. If they ace the quiz, they have the opportunity to receive a certificate of completion, a badge of valor in their Latin mastery, and redeemable for a piece of candy if they show up to Boot Camp again! My students can also reap the benefits of solid mastery by cashing in their certificates for grade bumps on quizzes and tests, exemptions from missing work, or candy. Encourage your student to join me for Latin Boot Camp on Tuesdays at Lyceum (directly after 2nd period). For best results, encourage students to attend weekly!
