## Notes from the Academic Dean

### State Testing

Arizona's Academic Standards Assessment (AASA) is the statewide achievement test for Arizona students in Grades 3-8. All Arizona public school students in these grades will take the grade level assessments. In addition, high school students will take statewide achievement tests. Here at NPX, tests will be administered as follows:

- 3/28 - 11th Grade: Science Test
- 3/29 - 8th Grade: Science Test
- 4/4 - 7th Grade: AASA Writing Test
- 4/4 - 8th Grade: AASA Writing Test
- 4/5 - 9th Grade: Aspire Exam**
- 4/5 - 10th Grade: PACT Exam**
- 4/5 - 11th Grade: ACT Exam**
- 4/7 - 7th Grade: AASA ELA/Math Part 1
- 4/7 - 8th Grade: AASA ELA/Math Part 1
- 4/8 - 7th Grade: AASA ELA/Math Part 2
- 4/8 - 8th Grade: AASA ELA/Math Part 2

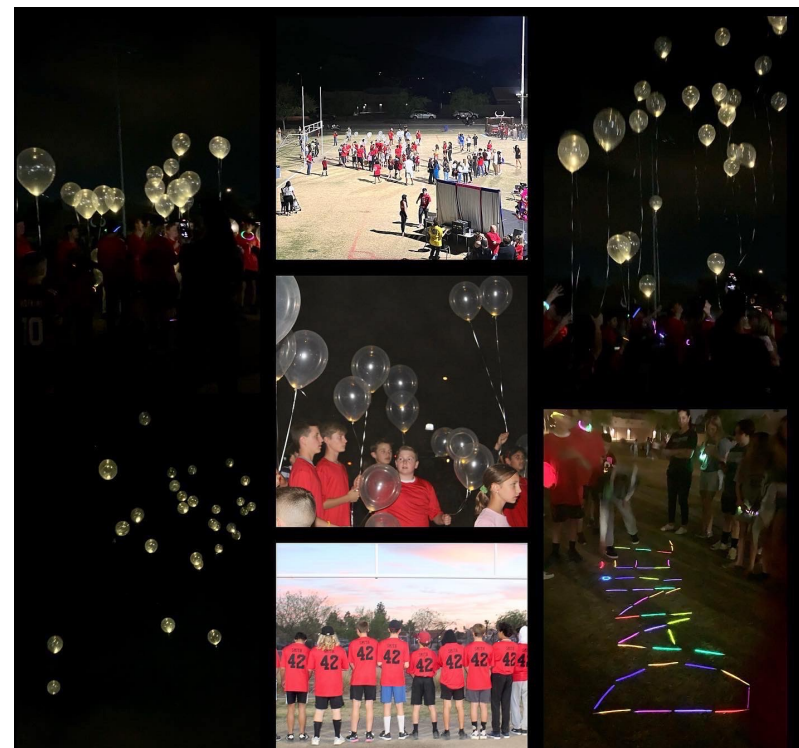
## 2022-2023 Enrollment - \*ACTION NECESSARY\*

1. Log in to the enrollment Parent Portal using your email address and password.
2. Please click HERE to create/update your password if needed.
3. Once in the enrollment Parent Portal, please click on the RE-ENROLL NOW button.
4. Select your student/s and click on the green START RE-ENROLLMENT button.
5. Answer all questions and e-sign the questionnaire at the end.
  - Repeat steps 4 and 5 for each student you are re-enrolling.

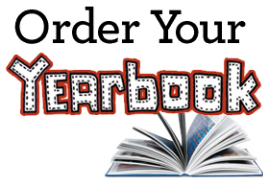

## Cell Phone Usage

## Absences

When a student is absent and in need of make-up work, they should first check the Weekly Homework Chart for assignments. Should they have questions or need additional assignments, they are to email their teacher(s) directly. Please do not ask the attendance line to acquire assignments for your student. If items need to be picked up from campus, teachers will leave these items in the front office.

## Tardies

We are now requiring any appointments (e.g., medical, dental, etc.) reported as a tardy to bring the documentation/slip from that office for auditing purposes. At time of check in, our Raptor system, allows to select reason for tardy " Doctor/Dentist or appointments, a slip must be given to our Front Desk team upon entry.
