APPLICATION PROCESS

PERSONAL STATEMENT

Rough Draft Due: Saturday, August 20 Final Draft Due: Tuesday, September 13

Learn more about this year's <u>CommonApp essay prompts</u> (or personal statement). The personal statement provides you an opportunity to tell your story outside of test scores and grades plus demonstrate college readiness. Supplemental essays (if required) will be due Friday, September 30.

We require that you attend a personal statement workshop to receive feedback from your College Counselors. Email <u>your Counselors</u> a link to your outline or draft in Google Docs for feedback!

RESUME

A strong college application resume clearly and concisely conveys to admissions committees your accomplishments and experiences outside of the classroom. Check out <u>tips and templates</u> to up-level your resume from the College Essay Guy.

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

If you have yet to send requests and/or receive confirmation from faculty recommenders, please send your requests **as soon as possible**. We will add their names to your Naviance account at the Bootcamp.

Complete the <u>Student Self-Assessment</u> and email a copy to your <u>College Counselors</u>. Please save your document as *"first name last name* self-assessment" and in pdf format.

Request your teacher letters of recommendation by email. Ideally, select teachers from 10th-12th grades (Humane Letters and ONE from the core subject of science or math.) If you plan to study fine arts, you may select ONE fine arts teacher. Send your self-assessment to your confirmed recommenders within 24-hours and copy your <u>College Counselors</u> on the email.
