Drop-Off and Pick-Up

Traffic Flow - See Map Here!

Thank you, parents and guardians, for a successful first week dropping your scholars off for learning and picking them up to head home. A few key reminders to help our traffic flow (which will get faster, we promise!):

- •The **only** way to enter campus is from 32nd Street, on the North side/Archway side of campus. Prep families should enter the outermost lane and travel around the field until the reach the Prep side of campus.
- •Hearn Road is a public street not a student drop-off/pick-up road. Please mind the signs and keep your children safe by not allowing them/encouraging them to jaywalk.

Morning Specifics

- •All students must be dropped off along the curb (closest to the building). Please pull all the way up (past the crosswalk if possible), to drop students off along the curb.
- •Exit in a single line (staying along the curb).
- If you have students on both campuses, you may drop them off along the Archway curb (with Prep students walking around

the building to the Prep entrance) or you may drop them off along the Prep curve (with Archway students **walking around** the building to the Archway entrance. Walking through campus to cut across is not permissible.

•Please be advised there is no drop-off along the field or near the gym.

Afternoon Specifics

- It is encouraged that you do not enter the car line until 3:30pm (or 2:15 on Wednesdays). Archway will be dismissing students beginning at 3:00pm. The fewer Prep parents in the car line will help move through their dismissal faster, allowing Prep dismissal to begin when the first students exit a few minutes past our **3:30pm dismissal time**.
- •Once your car passes the field, you may choose one of two pickup lanes along the curb (same as drop-off) or along the row of cars (South side of the parking lot).
- •Once you have your scholar(s) in the car, you may enter the center lane to exit campus.
- •Students **must use the crosswalk** at all times. Please do not allow or encourage your child to cut across the parking lot to enter your vehicle.



Parking on Campus

Please be mindful of signage that designates Faculty Parking spots. We have just enough parking spots for our faculty and administration and when a spot is taken, even if it may be for a short period of time, our faculty is left

scrambling for a spot - which may make them late to teach! Thank you in advance for parking in the guest designated spots in front of school, or in Visitor parking spots near the Archway playground.

From the Deans - Dress Code Reminders

Hello, Students!


We've had several questions about dress code, so here are a few excerpts from the <u>Family Handbook</u> as we head into our second week of school:

- **Shoes**: "Students may wear all black low top athletic shoes or black leather or simulated leather dress shoes."
- **Socks**: "Socks must be solid black in color, extend at least two inches above the ankle at crew length and be free of visible brand logos, patterns or decorations
- **Jewelry**: "All jewelry must be tasteful and worn in a non-distracting manner. Students are permitted to wear one watch, one finger ring and one necklace. Only simple, fine-gauged, 16 to 20-inch, silver or gold chain necklaces are permitted. Necklaces must be worn inside the shirt. One charity/motivational bracelet may be worn to support an appropriate cause provided it does not make inappropriate allusions."
- **Hair:** "Hair should be neatly combed or styled. Hair must be above the top of the shirt collar. Hair should be styled so that it does not fall below the eyebrows or past the midpoint of the ear. Hair must be natural looking and conservative in its color and cut (no unnatural streaking/highlighting, no artificial jet-black coloring, and no unnatural colors).
- **Girls Makeup/Nail Polish**: "Girls may wear subtle make-up applied tastefully and in moderation. Fingernails may be painted with solid colors of nail polish, but no glitter or patterns. Fingernails must be conservatively manicured. Tasteful French manicures are acceptable.

Absences

If items need to be picked up from campus, teachers will leave these items in the front office.
