Academy Giving Spotlight... College Counseling

Because of the financial support we receive through Community Investment, we are able to offer an individualized approach to college counseling that focuses on finding the right fit for each student.

College Counseling's mission is Exposure, Experience, and 1:1 Support for each student. Beginning freshmen year, we visit Humane Letters classes to engage students in conversations about college preparation in addition to core values and interests. At a minimum, NPX hosts 40 campus visits by college admissions representatives to expose high school students to institutions nationwide. Juniors and their parents may participate in the Great Hearts College Symposium on April 1, a network-wide college fair. Great Hearts contracts with Naviance, a college planning portal, and students receive access junior year. In collaboration with staff, this portal enables students to first search for college fit and eventually houses college lists, letters of recommendation, essay submissions, and more. The first Wednesday of every month, Juniors participate in must-attend college workshops after school. Senior year is comprised of regular individual student check-ins, essay reviewing, mock interviews, and ongoing support for post-secondary aspirations.
