### **Textbook Deposit**

One-time deposit of \$175 for new students ONLY

A one-time book deposit of \$175 is required upon enrollment to the school (grades 7-12) and is refunded when the student graduates or withdraws from the school so long as all textbooks have been returned in good condition each year.



### **Grade Level Supply List**
