on our regular days (8:20am - 3:30pm). All students will follow the same bell schedule on Early Release Wednesdays (8:20am - 1:15pm).

Lunch

We are pleased to partner with Blue Willo Catering this year. There will be daily hot and cold lunch options offered. Students may pay by cash or card on a



daily basis (online ordering will not be offered at this time). Vending machines will also be available before school, and during the Rec and Lunch periods. Students may certainly bring snacks and lunches from home. **We strongly encourage names to be written on all lunch boxes and water bottles.**

<u>Sibling Pickup</u>

NPX students will pick up their younger sibling in a designated area. Blue placard cards will not be needed. The only exit for students will be on the Prep side of campus. Parents picking up students from both campuses are asked to not get into the pickup line until 3:30 (regular days) and 1:30 (Wednesdays). Please stay in the outermost lane for Prep side pick up at all times.

Middle School News

It was wonderful to see so many of you at Greet the Gladiator, and to share your excitement for the first day of school! In preparation for Wednesday, we want to share a few Middle School procedures with you to make your first days as a Gladiator as smooth as possible.

Students may enter the building at 7:50 each morning, at which time they should go to their lockers, put away their cell phones and smart watches (powered off!), and gather their materials.

Locker visits are permitted before school, before Rec, and before Lunch. Students should gather their materials for their next two classes, bring them to their next classroom, and then head outside to the courtyard. Since our first day is a Wednesday, they should bring their materials for periods 1-3 to their first period class. Teachers will be available in the hallway to help with lockers and to let students know what they need to bring to class.

Teachers will meet their classes in the courtyard and along the fence to line up before first period. Signs are posted to designate meeting areas for each class.

Teachers will check dress code during 1st period, and will be giving reminders about dress code throughout the first three days of school. Dress code Notas will be issued beginning on Monday, 8/14, for any students whose uniforms are out of compliance. The Deans will follow up with these students to address dress code infractions.

Great Hearts and North Phoenix Preparatory Academy continue to utilize the system School Messenger for emails, robo calls, and text messaging to inform families of campus related academy emergencies and other communications. **SchoolMessenger has a new automatic**

opt-in for text feature. During the registration/re-enrollment process families confirmed their wish to participate in text communications. Great Hearts will now automatically opt in contact information given during the registration/re-enrollment process with the options you selected. You will notice at the beginning of July you will be opted in for text messaging. If you would like to opt out of text messages simply reply STOP to the text from 67585. You can also enter the code 67585 with the message STOP to block any text messaging. Please note, if opting out, you will not receive texts regarding emergencies on campus.

Reporting Absences

To report your scholar(s) absence, please provide an **email to Attendance@NorthPhoenixPrep.org** with the following information:

- 1. Student(s) First and Last Name
- 2. Grade
- 3. Date of Absence(s)
- 4. Reason for absence (please be specific)

Please provide an email to the attendance line before 9:00 am. Without an email, we will send a robo call and ask that you respond quickly so we may clear the absence. Note: All absences will be marked unexcused should we not hear from you.

Absences

When a student is absent and in need of make-up work, they should first check the Weekly Homework Chart for assignments. Should they have questions or need additional assignments, they are to email their teacher(s) directly. Please do not ask the attendance line to acquire assignments for your student. If items need to be picked up from campus, teachers will leave these items in the front office.

Tardies

We ask that any appointments (e.g., medical, dental, etc.) reported as a tardy to bring the documentation/slip from that office for auditing purposes. At time of check in, our Raptor system, allows to select reason for tardy "Doctor/Dentist or appointments." Please note that if a student is tardy more than 3 times, a detention will be issued. In addition, parents **must** sign students late to 1st period into school when tardy. (this excludes students who drive themselves).
