# Teachers List

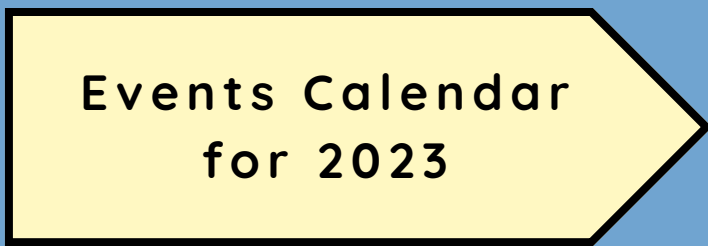
This is the first time that we have had no new purchases!!! We are still at 49%, 138 out of 278, and fell short of our 50% goal but we got really close.
