PSO works with school student leadership groups for most of our events.

<u>Lanista:</u> Open to high school students. Members lead the Gladiator Teams, comprising middle school students, and coordinate events like Familia Fridays and Field Days. Their main objective is to facilitate positive connections among younger students and instill an understanding of our school culture.

<u>Student Service Organization (SSO)</u>: Dr. Mann oversees the Student Service Organization, which welcomes both middle and high school students. They contribute to event setup and cleanup, organize initiatives such as the Angel Tree, and provide assistance during concerts and plays, among other tasks.

<u>Mentors:</u> Operated by Mr. Black and Ms. Hatch, the Mentors program is exclusive to high school students selected through a rigorous application process. The objective is to introduce new students to our school's culture, values, and environment. Mentors meet with their assigned group weekly, offering guidance and support.

<u>Pantheon:</u> Designed for eighth-grade students the Pantheon program introduces students to leadership concepts and involves them in middle school-specific events. Additionally, they collaborate with the PSO to plan middle school social activities.

<u>Senate</u>: The Senate is open to high school students. Primarily, the Senate serves as the grade level leaders, organizing high school social events, dances, and Prom. Additionally, they form an advisory council to address specific campus needs in collaboration with the administration, such as mental health initiatives. Membership is selective through a rigorous process.
