HOMEWORK CHARTS

Homework charts are sent out on Monday mornings, apart from holidays. Each grade level will have a link and you will be able to see what each teacher is assigning for homework each day. Please understand that these could change, due to many factors and your child's planner should be the first source of information.

MISSING ASSIGNMENT REPORTS (MAR's)

Missing assignment reports are sent out on Fridays, starting on the third Friday of the quarter. This communication is to inform you of what your student is missing. The first report of each quarter will encompass the first three weeks. After the first report is sent, the report will capture only the current and prior week.

Please know what each teacher's late work policy is and if you have specific questions about assignments, please reach out directly to the teacher.

MIDQUARTER PROGRESS REPORTS (MQPR's)

This communication will be sent to ALL families in the third and sixth week of each quarter. This report will give you a snapshot of what your child's current grades are in each class. The first one of each quarter may not have grades in each category or very few grades. Please reach out directly to your child's teacher if you have specific questions or concerns.

- 4. Reason for absence (please be specific)

Please provide an email to <u>attendance@northphoenixprep.org</u> **before 8:00am**. A notification reminder will be sent mid-morning to those who have not indicated, via email, that the student is missing school. Absences will be marked unexcused if an email is not received or if the reason for absence is anything other than illness, doctor appointment, bereavement, family emergency or suspension.

Tardies

Students arriving late to campus must check in through the front office. For auditing purposes, all tardies due to an appointment (e.g., medical, dental, etc.) will be marked unexcused until a note is received; and we ask that parents sign in their scholar at the front desk. If a student is tardy more than 3 times, a detention will be issued.

Absences

When a student is absent and in need of make-up work, they should first check the Weekly Homework Chart for assignments. Should they have questions or need additional assignments, they are to email their teachers directly.

Gladiator Gear

Outerwear
