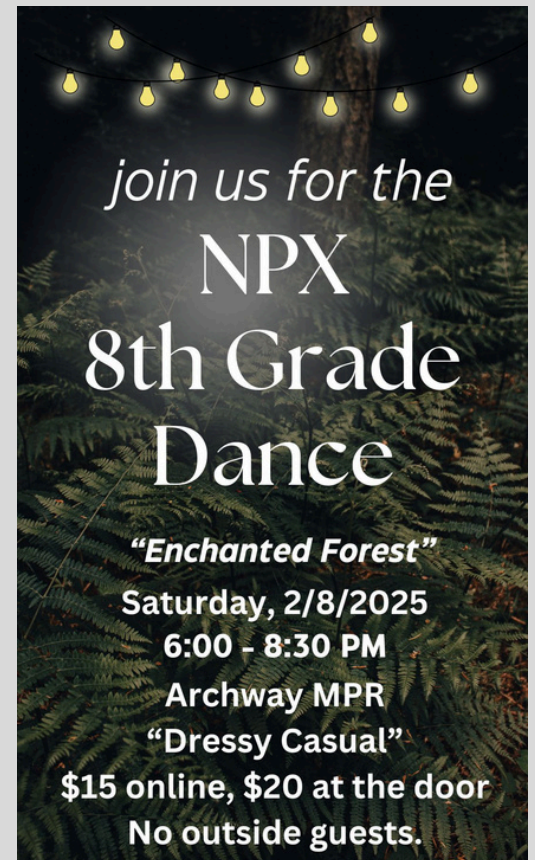

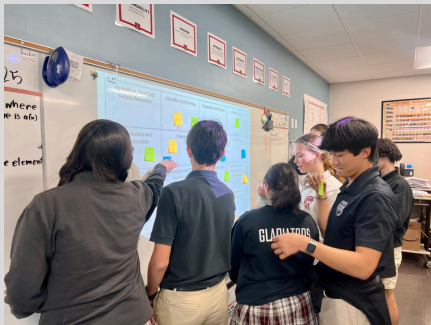
COLLEGE COUNSELING
