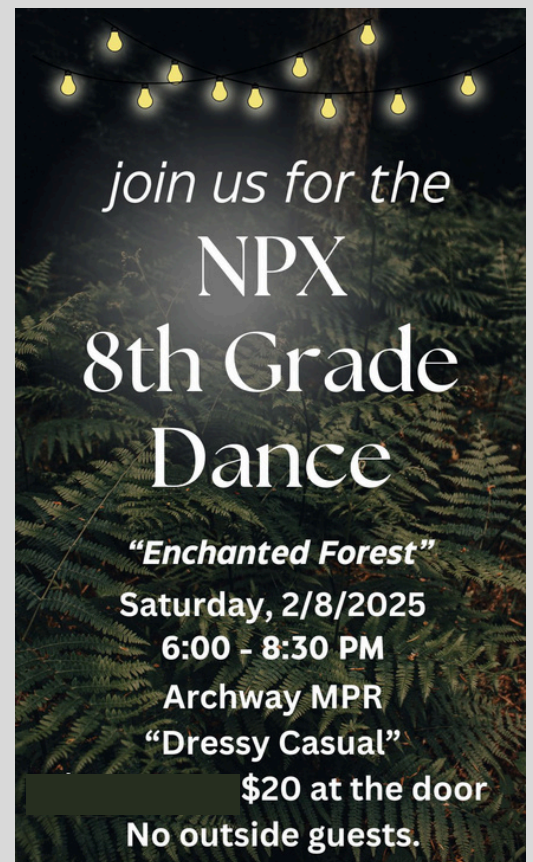

It's TAX CREDIT SEASON!



Dear Gladiators Family,

Thank you for your continued support in North Phoenix Prep's athletics and enrichment courses. We are asking families to partner with us by contributing your annual Public School Tax Credit.

WHAT IS TAX CREDIT

It is a program through the Arizona Department of Revenue that gives Arizona taxpayers the opportunity to contribute to athletics and enrichment courses at the public school of their choice. In return, you will receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit on your Arizona state income tax.

Step 1: Contribute by April 15th and save receipt

Step 2: File your state income taxes and claim your contribution using Arizona Form 322.

Step 3: Receive your Tax Credit back dollar-for-dollar on your state income taxes

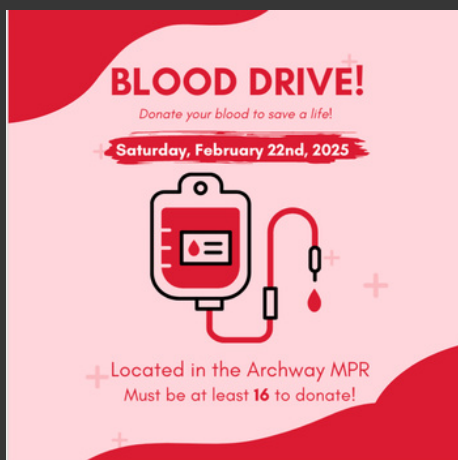

From the Front Office: Procedures and Policies Overview

Unexcused absences will be marked if no email is received.

Tardies: Late students must check in at the front office. Tardies for appointments will be unexcused until a note is provided. After 3 tardies, a detention is issued.
