


EARN COLLEGE CREDIT

Great Hearts Academies are expanding their college credit offerings again this coming year. This will include three <u>AP testing</u> sites, three <u>CLEP testing</u> sites, and additional <u>dual enrollment</u> courses.

Dual Enrollment

Students entering grades 10-12 can earn college credit for select high school courses they are already taking at North Phoenix Prep. Each dual enrollment course is taught by the student's regular Great Hearts teacher.

- <u>Register online</u> by August 24th for fall semester dual enrollment courses. Please have your student's high school transcript and course offerings handy.
- Create a separate Great Hearts AZ Configio account.





Leaving Items/Lunches at the front Desk:
