



#### SENIOR FAMILY REMINDERS

Submit your 2026-2027 <u>Free Application for Federal Student Aid</u> (FAFSA) in about 30 minutes! Families must complete the FAFSA form to be eligible for federal student aid, such as federal grants, work-study funds, and loans. *Priority deadline: January 15*After submitting your FAFSA, apply for the \$2,000 <u>College Ready AZ FAFSA Scholarship</u>.

#### Leaving Items/Lunches at the front Desk:
