NPX Dismissal Policy Change



Students will be required to have a signed permission slip or be escorted by a parent to leave campus at dismissal as a "Walker." Permission slips are due back to first period teachers by Friday, 12/12/25.

Beginning on 1/5/2026, students without the permission slip will not be permitted to exit the parking lot and must remain on the sidewalk outside the Academic building to be picked up in the drive line.

Archway students will not be permitted to exit the parking lot unless they are escorted by a Prep sibling with the tag. Student drivers parked in the student lot are not subject to this restriction.

Final Exam Policy

The Family Handbook policy regarding missing work due to excused absences is found on page 31:

"It is the responsibility of the student to make up all missed assignments after an excused absence from school. If a student is unable to attend school and seeks their assignments, the student or parent/guardian should contact the teacher. Each teacher will have an established make-up policy, including appropriate deadlines, for missed work. Parents/guardians may receive a detailed attendance report upon request from the school office."

If a student misses a final exam due to an excused absence, the student will have as many days as they are absent to make up the exam, or additional days at the teacher's discretion.

If a student misses a final exam due to an unexcused absence, the student should be prepared to make up the exam upon their return to school at the teacher's first opportunity to administer the test

Should a teacher not be able to grade the exam prior to the issuance of report cards, the student may receive a grade of Incomplete (I) until the exam grade is entered. At that time, the grade will be updated and parents will receive notification of the grade.

In the case that a student withdraws from North Phoenix Prep prior to the end of the quarter, their grades will be transferred to their new school as they stand on the date of their withdrawal.



Leaving Items/Lunches at the front Desk:

All lunches, water bottles, and other items must be dropped off at the front desk before 10:00 AM. Items dropped off at the front desk after 10:00 AM - The student will not be called down until the next day of school for pickup (lunches included). This is to avoid classroom interruptions.

Reporting Absences:

- Grade
- Date of Absence(s)
- Reason (illness, appointment, family emergency,

Unexcused absences will be marked if no email is received.

Tardies: Late students only must check in at the front office. Parents are no longer needed to check in student. Tardies for appointments will be unexcused until a note is provided. After 3 tardies, a detention is issued.
